Metropolitan Golf Club Player of the Year

This Program is designed to identify and declare a "Player of the Year" (POY) based on points accrued during regular club tournaments.

A Tournament of Champions (TOC) will be played in September and following the TOC the highest point winner will be the Metropolitan Golf Club Player of the Year.

Players may qualify by being gross score champion or a net flight winner in stroke play tournaments from February through August. Players can also qualify by being one of the final two players in both the Team Match Play and Individual Match Play tournaments. All qualifiers must have played in at least 2 MGC Tournaments between January and September.

Points Qualifying:

The field for TOC will be rounded out with players in the POY point system within 425 points of the leader as of September 15th. Any Tournament Qualifier not within 425 points of the leader will be reset to 425 points behind the leader for TOC.

POY points will be awarded as follows for finish in each Flight for Stroke Play Tournaments Feb-Sept (Excluding Senior and Away tournaments).

- 2) 175
- 3) 125
- 4) 100
- 5) 75
- 6) -10) 50
- 11) and down 25

Points Doubled for Major Events (NCGA Zone Q, NCGA Net Am, Club Championship and TOC).

Match Play Tournaments

<u>Individual:</u> 50 points for all players in Round 1, then 25 points per additional round played. Champion receives 250 points.

<u>Team Match Play</u>: All Players receive 75 points in Round 1, then 25 points per additional round played. Champions receive 150 points.

Withdraw/Did not Finish - A player must play 14 holes (enough for a postable round) to receive POY Points. For 2 day tournaments, players who only play 1 day receive 50% of points accrued, IE if 25 were to be allotted, they would receive 13. 50, they would receive 25.

No Show, Late withdraw. Failure to report for a tournament that you have signed up for without notice = 50 point POY deduction. Withdrawal within 48 hours of tournament subject to 25 point POY deduction. Both instances have the option for the player to appeal to the MGC Tournament Committee for reduction/removal of points penalty.
